Project

The S\$160m Singapore Flyer project is currently the world's largest Giant Observation Wheel (GOW) completed in February 2008. The Singapore Flyer stands at a height of 165m, with a wheel diameter of 150m and 28 capsules each holding up to 28 passengers. With a building Gross Floor Area of 13,000m² comprising retail and food & beverage outlets, the Singapore Flyer also presents landscape greenery and water features, as well as car park facilities provided on an adjacent building. The construction contract is a turnkey EPC contract based on a design and build and contractor-financing arrangement.
